

## **Tandragee Rovers** **Summary of Activities**

Many of the local community clubs within the Tandragee Area have had difficulty finding a meeting place that was neutral and with proper facilities to fulfil their needs. For example, there was a lack of disabled toilets, showers, access ramps, changing facilities, meeting rooms and an external area for other activities.

As a result of this noticeable gap in facilities Tandragee Rovers has set out to improve facilities with the help of the Local Council and local donations.

Our main activity will be to provide buildings and grounds for many users within the community. We will manage and administer the facilities for the benefit of the whole area. Our primary aim is to provide and maintain the centre for use by local voluntary groups; we will be encouraging local groups and other charities to use the centre. We foresee that the centre will be used for the following activities. The grounds and hall will be used by a local amateur football club. The football club will benefit the young in the area by providing them with a leisure activity that will encourage them to stay fit and healthy and socialise with others around their age. We plan to provide a meeting place for local community groups who otherwise would find it difficult to find a place to meet. We will provide facilities for a local road racing club "Tandragee 100", the Madden Rural Community Group and Cusher Bridge Game Club. In addition we will provide a training area for local youth and disabled persons to encourage them to remain healthy and improve their life.

When our plans are realised the numbers of local community groups will increase because they will have a suitable place to go and carry out their activities. This will benefit the whole community by providing a place within the community where people can meet and get to know each other.

By providing facilities for activities we are benefiting the whole community; we are providing them with a chance to take part in programmes that will improve their physical well-being by providing facilities for exercise and leisure. We bring the community together and encourage them to co-operate with each other in order to enhance their community by providing the facilities and encouraging people to use them. We will run our organisation according to our constitution.
